## Additional Guidelines for Sidewalk and Curb Projects

- 1. A Pennsylvania One Call must be submitted at least three days prior to beginning work. 1-800-242-1776.
- 2. When work is being done on a State roadway, a copy of the PennDOT Highway Occupancy Permit must be at the work site.
- 3. Work Zone Traffic Control must be set up as per the latest regulations from PennDOT on any street or roadway.
- 4. The work area must be kept safe and clean.
- 5. Sleeves for signs must be installed as directed by the Borough PW Department.
- 6. Prior to pouring concrete, a form inspection must me scheduled. Please give at least 24 hours notice when requesting an inspection.
- 7. All work must comply with current Borough and PennDOT regulations and specifications.
